

BASIC SCAFFOLD

OHSCER219A – PERFORM BASIC SCAFFOLDING OPERATIONS

OVERVIEW: To be **competent** the person should be able to:

1. Plan and prepare work.
2. Erect scaffolding/equipment.
3. Inspect, repair and alter scaffolding/equipment.
4. Dismantle scaffolding/equipment.

NOMINAL DURATION: Up to 40 Hrs (Training Only). Please note a further 120 hr nominal period involving completing a log book (on the job) maybe required prior to assessment.

PREREQUISITES: Minimum 18years. Participants should have sufficient literacy and numeracy skills to read and comprehend instructions for working safely.

ASSESSMENT AND AWARD: On successful completion of the course including the assessment, the participant will receive a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment and be issued with an Occupational Health & Safety Certificate to perform basic scaffold operations. Participants who demonstrate competency by passing the theory, written and verbal assessments will receive a Statement of Attainment for partial completion of the Nationally Recognised Training Package – 30497QLD Course in Operating Crane, Rigging and Scaffolding Equipment.
