

WORK SAFELY IN A CONFINED SPACE

MSAPMPER205B – ENTER CONFINED SPACE
MSAPMPER200B – WORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN ISSUED PERMIT
MSAPMOHS200A – WORK SAFELY
MSAPMOHS217A – GAS TEST ATMOSPHERES

OVERVIEW: This training applies to persons who are required to enter confined space for maintenance purposes, for cleaning or simply inspection. It is required by all persons who are required to enter a confined space, as defined by the standard AS2865/2001, or its authorised update or replacement. It is expected that all standby persons will also be competent to enter confined space.

NOMINAL DURATION: Up to 2 Days

PREREQUISITES: None, however Senior First Aid certificate or equivalent competency is highly recommended. Participants should have sufficient literacy and numeracy skills to read and comprehend instructions for working safely. They will also need to possess sufficient physical ability which may be required to be used involved in crawling within restricted work areas as well as lifting, carrying or dragging people and/or property within these spaces.

COURSE CONTENT: Upon successful completion applicant will be able to

- ◆ Identify confined space and determine risk
- ◆ Apply risk management concepts - hazards
- ◆ Select and apply appropriate PPE, fall prevention and rescue equipment
- ◆ Control confined space entry
- ◆ Define roles and responsibilities of key personnel
- ◆ Work in accordance with a permit entry system
- ◆ Monitor hazardous atmospheres
- ◆ Apply basic emergency procedures
- ◆ Conclude confined space operations

ASSESSMENT AND AWARD: Participants who demonstrate competency by passing the theory, written and verbal assessment will receive a Statement of Attainment for partial completion of the Nationally Recognised Training Package – MSA20107 Certificate II in Process M:
