

DOGGER

OHSCER218A – PERFORM DOGGING OPERATIONS

OVERVIEW: The dogger licence (certificate) encompasses the application of correct slinging techniques, selection and inspection of lifting gear, direction of the crane/hoist operator in the movement of the load including when the load is out of view of the operator.

NOMINAL DURATION: Up to 40 Hrs (Training Only). Please note a further 120 hr nominal period involving completing a log book (on the job) maybe required prior to assessment.

PREREQUISITES: Minimum 18 years of age. Participants should have sufficient literacy and numeracy skills to read and comprehend instructions for working safely.

COURSE CONTENT: Upon successful completion applicant will be able to

Workplace Health and Safety Legislation	Plan work and prepare work
Hazards and hazard controls	Assess weight of load
Calculate and determine crane capabilities	Work with other plant operators and personnel to move and place loads
Selection of slings and signalling	Determine mass of irregular shaped loads
Practical and theory assessments	Implement appropriate corrective action in an emergency situation

ASSESSMENT AND AWARD: On successful completion of the course including the written and practical assessment, the participant will receive a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment for partial completion of the Nationally Recognised Training Package – 30497QLD Course in Operating Crane, Rigging and Scaffolding Equipment as well as qualifying for an Occupational Health & Safety Licence (Certificate) to perform dogging operations.
