

GENERAL SAFETY INDUCTION -CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY- (WHITE CARD)

CPCCOHS1001A – Work Safely in the Construction Industry

OVERVIEW: All people doing construction work in Queensland must have successfully completed this competency which is recognised by Queensland law before they start work in any construction activity. This course provides participants basic skills and knowledge in relation to risk management and relevant workplace health and safety obligations and requirements within the construction industry.

COST: \$80.00 (GST not applicable)
Purchase orders accepted from businesses.

NOMINAL DURATION: Approximately 5 hours

PREREQUISITES: None, however Participants should have sufficient literacy and numeracy skills to read and comprehend instructions for working safely.

COURSE CONTENT: Upon successful completion applicant will be able to

Appropriate legislative requirements and responsibilities

Basic concepts of workplace health and safety plans and work method statements

Physical and construction hazards

Basic risk management concepts including hazard identification, assessment of risk, control of risk and evaluation of control measures

The hierarchy of controls (eliminate, substitute, redesign, isolate, administrate) and the use of personal protective equipment

Emergency procedures

ASSESSMENT AND AWARD: Participants who successfully complete the course including the assessment will receive a Statement of Attainment for partial completion of the Nationally Recognised Training Package – Certificate 1 in Construction and be issued with a laminated white card from Workplace Health & Safety Qld as evidence.
